Building back better - COVID recovery, resilience building and societal transformation

European research often has a focus on local or regional aspects of transformation, in particular in the context of COVID recovery. We want to broaden our horizon and put local aspects of societal transformation into a global context – from a citizen perspective. COVID has reset the global scene in many ways and offers a chance to rethink our approach to climate change (including resilience, transformation, adaptation, recovery and structural change). This is a chance to address (in)justice and (in)equalities in order to build back better. Based on one set of ongoing and past societal transformation project themes, questions will be asked to a broad range of actors (activists, scientists, citizens, policy makers).

Expected outcomes:

- A thorough and at the same time global perspective on visions for a just recovery.
- Exploration of different fields where climate change and COVID recovery intersect.
- Identification of indicators for scientists in which fields there is real demand for research from a practitioner's point of view.

Societal transformation towards climate resilient European regions and cities is a key policy target at all levels. In this webinar we want to form key messages that contribute to accelerating and scaling up local action in the field of climate change adaptation to support this target.
