Strategic objectives of research programme

- **After Stern Review and IPCC AR4:
need to give climate economics a boost + community and capacity building in DE.**
 - Cost of climate change mitigation and adaptation
 - Effectiveness of policy measures and instruments
 - Analysis of international negotiations and regimes
 - Economic instruments for the energy transition.

Strategic objectives of research programme

- **Analysis of strengths and weaknesses:**

- Strong in theory and model development.
- Lack of practical and empirical orientation.
- Strong visibility of some parts, little coherence within community.
- Lack of application and policy impact.

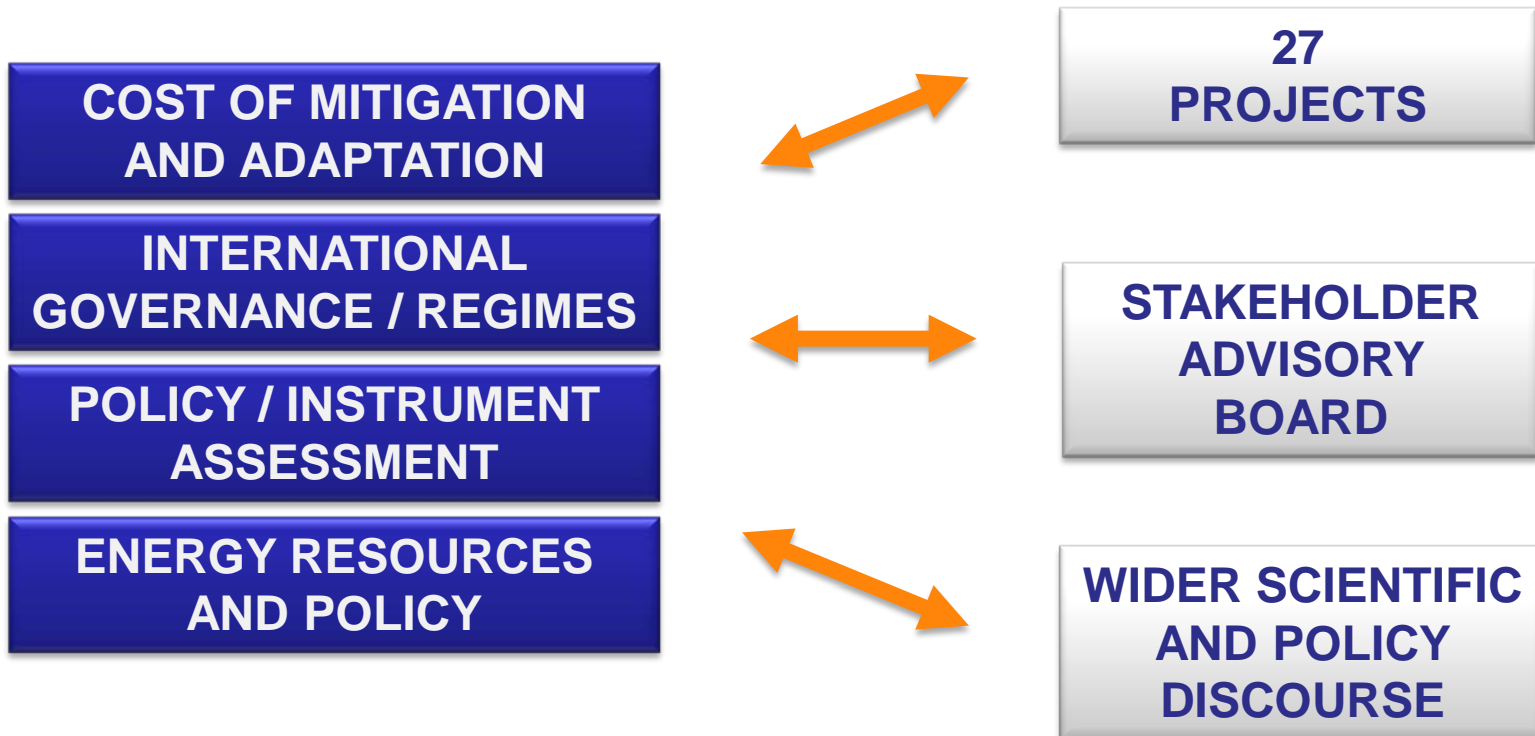

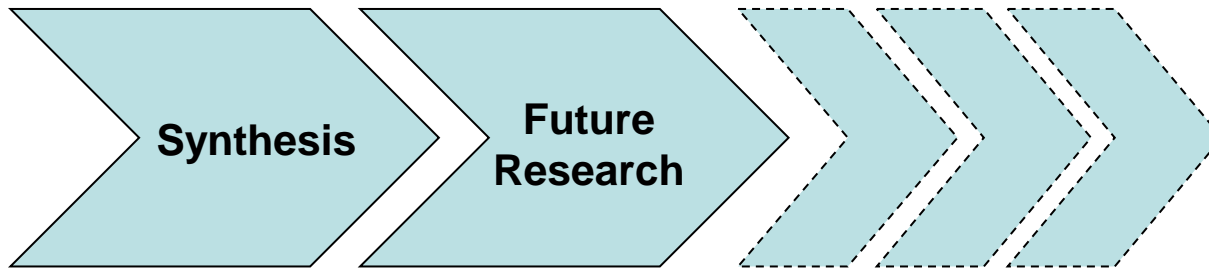
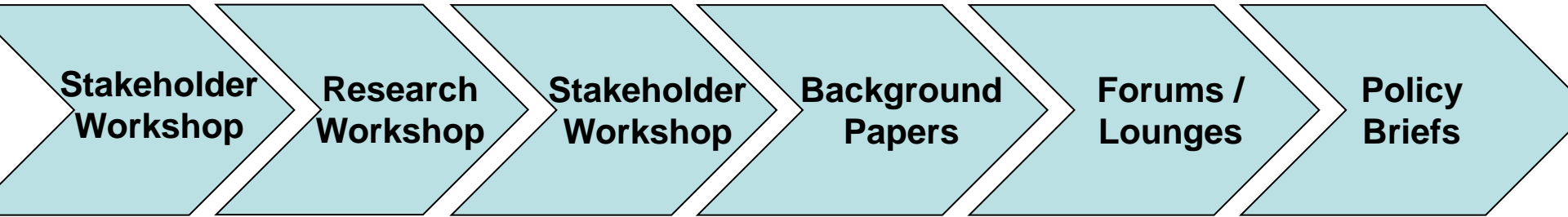
- **Reach out** to stakeholders: companies, NGOs, public administration, policy makers.

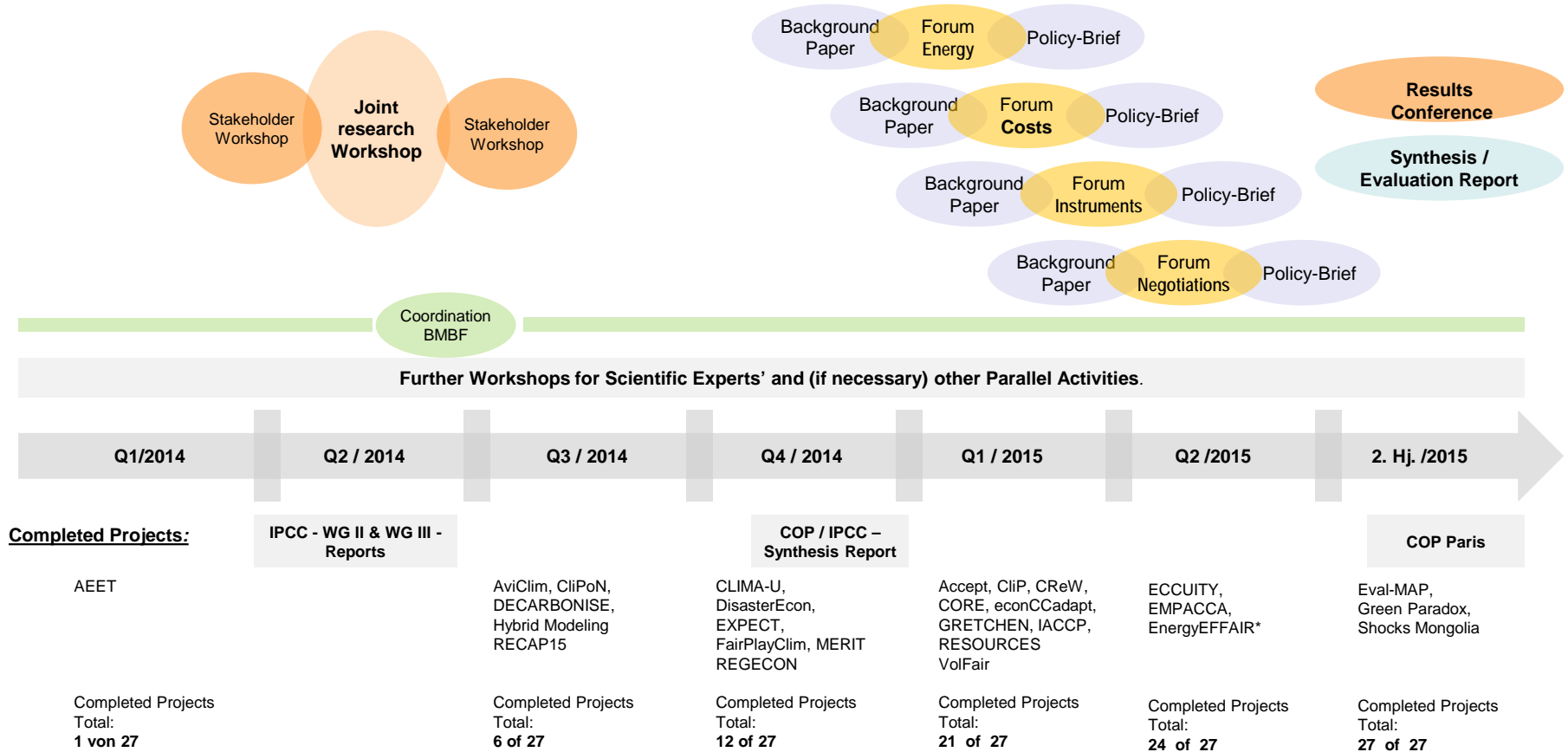
