#### Meeting Objective

The projects funded under JPI Climate's SOLSTICE call have reached their end. A few exceptions will conclude in 2024 due to extensions but for all SOLSTICE projects the end is in sight.

With this final meeting, researchers and research funders are able to take stock of the projects. It also serves as an opportunity to exchange on research gaps these projects have uncovered, and to discuss their project outcomes.

Firstly, we will have a roundtable where each project can present briefly how their work has informed societal transformation and what potential research gaps they have uncovered during their work.

Secondly, we will take a deeper dive into each project. Their scientific results, communication and dissemination activities, any obstacles they encountered along the way, and how they see the project's network and impact sustain beyond its lifetime.

We will conclude with another roundtable for participants to share what has stood out to them, what research gaps they would like to see considered in future activities, and where they see opportunities to extend the impact of SOLSTICE projects.
